The Star Valley Arts Council and the Ford Theatre are excited to provide this children's summer Theatre camp and produce Seussical, Jr., directed by Tina Crowther and Katie Thygerson! Who is this for? Children ages 6-16. All are welcome!

<u>Cost</u> to participate is \$75. Each additional member of a family costs \$50. Each participant will receive 2 free tickets to a performance. Pay via our website (preferred), Venmo @starvalleyarts, by check (made payable to Star Valley Arts Council) or cash. Please plan to pay at (or before) auditions. Tickets for the performances will cost \$8 per person.

<u>Auditions</u> will be held **Wednesday**, **June 5** at the Ford Theatre in Afton, from **1:00 pm-3:00 pm**. Come any time during that window. There will be a sign up sheet and kids will audition in order of the sign ups. Children should come prepared with a 1 minute song and ready to read a few lines from a Dr. Seuss book. There is a piano available, but no pianist. If children only want to participate as a chorus member, they do not need to audition on stage, but please have them come register and meet us!

Rehearsals will run from Friday, June 7 until the dress rehearsal Wednesday, June 26. Rehearsals will be held at the Ford Theatre in Afton, Because there are less than 20 rehearsals, cast members will be expected to participate in every rehearsal. Rehearsals will run from **10:00 am until noon** each day we have rehearsal, Monday through Saturday. There will NOT be a regular snack provided, please send a water bottle and a small snack with your child, if they need it. Please see the detailed rehearsal schedule below:

<u>Rules</u> are included on this sheet and on the participant contract. These are very important and children must be able to follow the rules in order for the camp to be a safe environment for everybody. Please read through the rules with your child and help them understand the importance of keeping them. We will contact you about a solution if your child is having a difficult time with this.

<u>Cast</u> parts will be given based on the child's audition. We will email the cast list out to parents the day after auditions. Please contact us immediately if your child will not be accepting their position. Please help your children to understand that their participation in this play is valuable, even if they are a member of the ensemble chorus, ALL parts matter. Not to mention they'll have a lot of fun! This is a great opportunity for everyone involved. Music will be shared via google drive when you receive the cast list- start listening and practicing right away!

<u>About</u> the directors: Tina Crowther loves singing and performing. She has a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education and a Master's degree in Child and Family Studies. Katie Thygerson has a bachelor's degree in Theatre Education and a Master's degree in Curriculum and Instruction. She taught middle school drama and directs the after-school plays at Etna Elementary, where she works as librarian. Both women love helping kids learn new skills and gain confidence as they work hard and have fun performing.
