

The Rockin' Tale of Snow White Summer Theatre Camp Info Sheet 2026

The Star Valley Arts Council and the Ford Theatre are excited to offer and produce the Children's Summer Theatre Camp event for 2026: ***The Rockin' Tale of Snow White***, directed by Katie Thygerson, Katherine Harris and Tina Crowther! Who is this for? Children ages 6-16. All are welcome!

Cost to participate is \$75. Each additional member of a family costs \$50. Each participant will receive 2 free tickets to a performance. Pay via our website (preferred), Venmo @starvalleyarts, by check (made payable to Star Valley Arts Council) or cash. Please plan to pay at (or before) auditions. Tickets for the performances will cost \$8 per person.

Auditions will be held **Wednesday, May 6 at 4:00-6:30ish**, at the Ford Theatre in Afton. Come any time during that window. There will be a sign up sheet and kids will audition in order of the sign ups. Children should come prepared with a 1 minute song. There is a piano available, but no pianist. *We invite children younger than ten to plan to participate as a chorus member, and they do not need to audition.* Please register them online or via email-summertheatrecampsv@gmail.com.

Rehearsals will begin **Monday, June 1**. Rehearsals will be held at the Ford Theatre in Afton. Rehearsals will run from **10:00 am until noon** each day we have rehearsal, Monday through Saturday. A snack will be provided. Please send a water bottle with your child, and please be on time to pick up your children after rehearsals. See the rehearsal schedule below:

Performance dates are Wednesday June 17, Thursday June 18, and Friday June 19 at 6:00 pm each day. Cast members need to be there by 5:30 pm. We'll invite the cast to spread the word about performances, so watch for information on that! The Ford Theatre provides concessions and we will have an intermission. Makeup is optional during performances and will be up to each performer to apply.

Costume ideas will be shared at the beginning of rehearsals, and we ask for any help you can offer finding and creating bright, unique and fun costumes for this bright, fun show! Some characters will need to provide a bright colored t-shirt, and black leggings, shorts or pants. Watch for more information with the cast list about costumes! Please contact us if you are interested in helping with costumes, props, or set design. We would love any help we can get!

Rules are included on this sheet and on the participant contract. These are very important and children must be able to follow the rules in order for the camp to be a safe environment for everybody. Please read through the rules with your child and help them understand the importance of keeping them. We will contact you about a solution if your child is having a difficult time with this.

Cast parts will be given based on the child's audition. We will email the cast list to parents within a few days after auditions. Please contact us immediately if your child will not be accepting their position. Please help your children to understand that their participation in this play is valuable, even if they are a member of the ensemble chorus, ALL parts matter. Not to mention they'll have a lot of fun! This is a great opportunity for everyone involved. Music will be shared via google drive when you receive the cast list. Start listening and practicing right away!
