- *4B or 6B charcoal pencil/ kneaded eraser/pearl eraser
- * Winsor & Newton Professional Retouching varnish 400ml can
- * Fixative
- Odorless mineral spirits (Gamblin Gamsol) 33.8 oz
- Brush cleaning container for Gamsol with lid (glass or metal)
- Gamblin Galkyd Medium (fast drying) 125 ml
- Gamblin Galkyd Light Medium (slower drying) 125 ml
- Gamblin Flake White Replacement Oil Paint (there is no lead in this paint) 150 ml
- Palette Knives (for mixing paints)
- Sturdy Painting Easel
- Sketchbook/ Notebook /paper towels/ trash bags

- #4 flat bristle

- #0 round bristle

| Greenish Umber x 2 (Utrecht only) 37ml | Yellow Ochre |
| Ivory Black | Cadmium Orange |
